

Jennings Dies In Pensacola

Funeral services for Wesley E. Jennings, 72, of Pensacola, Fla., who died Thursday, March 11, in a Pensacola hospital following several months' illness were held Monday morning, March 15, in Fisher-Pou Chapel with the Rev. Lawrence Carroll officiating.

Mr. Jennings was a native of the Ellijay section of Macon County, but had resided in Pensacola the last 50 years. He was a son of the late Mary K. and William Tolvin Jennings.
