

DEATH CLAIMS F. N. JOHNSON

Clarkeville Man's Death Caused by Stroke of Paralysis

Fred N. Johnson, 60, died at his home in Clarkeville, Ga., Monday morning at 3 o'clock. Death resulted from a stroke of paralysis a week ago.

Funeral services were held at the Cartoogechaye Baptist church Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock with the Rev. P. C. Burrell pastor of the First Baptist church of Clarkeville, having charge of the services.

Mr. Johnson was formerly of Macon county, having moved to Clarkeville about 20 years ago. He was superintendent of Carpenters of the Georgia Power company.

Mr. Johnson is survived by seven children; two sisters, Mrs. R. M. Ledford, of Franklin and Mrs. D. M. Sweatman, of Franklin, Route 1; two brothers, George Johnson, of Franklin Route 1, and Williams S. Johnson, of Birdsvew, Washington.
