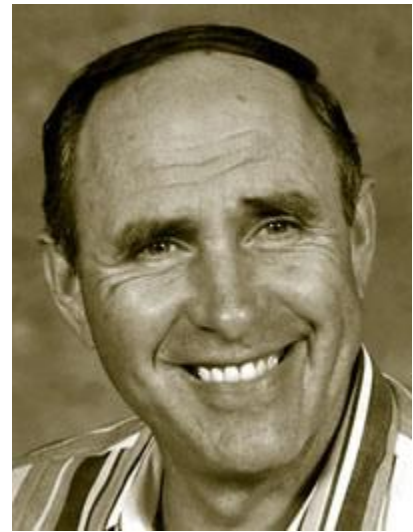
He worked for many years as a cable splicer and also with the N.C. State Bridge crew and retired from Whitley Products. He will be sadly missed by family and many close friends.
