

ACCIDENTALLY SHOT; JACKSON MAN DIES HERE

Cecil Jones, 25, an employee of the Blackwood Lumber company at East LaPorte, Jackson county, died at 2 a. m. Wednesday in Angel Brothers' hospital as a result of a bullet hole through his brain.

Jones was said to have shot himself accidentally with a .25 automatic pistol, the bullet striking just above his right ear and coming out at the top of his head. He was brought to the hospital here late Tuesday afternoon. He was unconscious and bleeding profusely. Every effort was made to save his life but, as the bullet passed through part of his brain, very little hope was held out for his recovery.
