

Last Rites Held For Mrs. Hettie Jones

Final services were held for Mrs. Hettie Baldwin Jones, 78-years-old, at 11 o'clock this morning at the Aquone Baptist church, conducted by Rev. Weldon West, of Andrews Baptist church.

Interment was the church burial ground where Mrs. Jones was a life-long member.

Pallbearers were: Baas, Lee, Lyle, and Newell Baldwin, nephews of the deceased, and Claude and Theodore Bateman.

Mrs. Jones died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. D. C. Carpenter, after an illness of three weeks. She had been in
