

Dr. T.D. Jones

Dr. Thomas Duane Jones, M.D., who had resided in the Carson Community for the past 14 years died in the Angel Community Hospital Sunday following an illness of six months.

A retired doctor, before coming to Franklin to live he had been a member of the staff of the Garfield Park Hospital, in Chicago, Ill.

He was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Franklin, the Junaluska Lodge No. 145 AF & AM and Araba Temple of Ft. Myers, Florida. A graduate of University of Michigan and Rush Medical College, he served three years in World War II.

Services were held Wednesday at the First United Methodist Church with Rev. Donald Haynes, pastor conducting the service and burial followed in Louisa Chapel United Methodist Church Cemetery.
