

Funeral Rites Held For Mrs. Laura Conley Justice

Final rites for Mrs. Laura P. Conley Justice, 60, were held at the Dryman Methodist church on Tuesday morning at 11:00 o'clock. The Rev. V. N. Allen, pastor, officiating, assisted by the Rev. W. Jackson Hunecutt, pastor of the Franklin Methodist church. Interment was in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Dryman died at her home in the Tesenta section of Macon county on Monday morning at 8 o'clock, following a lingering illness of 18 months.
