Julius William Justus, age 84, of Lone Oak Rd., Grovetown, Ga., formerly of Rabun County, died Tuesday Nov. 26, 2002, at his home in Grovetown.

Born in Rabun County May 20, 1918 he was the son of the late Wesley and Cora Robinson Justus. He was also preceded in death by a son, Tim Justus. He was a retired staff sergeant from the U.S. Army, having enlisted in Nov. 1941 and retiring after service in World War II and Vietnam and the years in between. He retired in November of 1967 and was also retired from Owens Corning Fiberglass Co.
