Funeral services were held for Pfc. Lawton Arvil Keener, who was killed in Viet Nam January 12, at the Gold Mine Baptist Church. Taking part in the service were Rev. Mack Reed, Rev. William Wooten, Rev. Earl Dendy, Rev. Otis Gregg and Rev. Alton Dendy.

A military detachment from Fort McPherson, Atlanta, Ga., served as pallbearers and conducted military graveside rites. Burial was in the church cemetery.
