

## Keller, Caldwell Native Dies Here

Henry Leroy Keller, a native of Caldwell County, who had lived in this county for several years, died December 13 at his home on Franklin, Route 2. He was 88 years old and had been ill for about 21 weeks.

Funeral services were conducted in the afternoon at the Watauga Baptist Church by the Rev. Lee Crawford and burial was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Keller was born March 25, 1864, and in 1894 was married to Miss Susan Dykes, of Tennessee.
