

## *Mrs. Kelly*

Daphne Palmer Kelly, 81, of Randolph St., Franklin, formerly of Bryson City and Delray Beach, Fla., died Thursday, June 6, in a local nursing home. She was born in Pahang, Malaya, a daughter of the late Horace Haden and Violet Gates Palmer. She was married to Myron V. (Pete) Kelly, who predeceased her. She was a homemaker and a member of St. Agnes Episcopal Church, where she was a member of the Choir, Daughters of the King and Christian Woman's Club. She graduated from Palm Beach High School in 1938 and Palm Beach Junior College in 1940. She was the first woman graduate of Civil Aviation Authority Course in Palm Beach County in 1940, and one of the first female pilots in South Florida.

She is survived by one son, Brian H. Kelly and his wife, Sharon, of Bryson City; and daughter, Diane K. Campion and her husband, Michael, of Marietta, Ga.; one brother, William J. Palmer of Bowie, Md.; three grandchildren; one great-grandchild; and several nieces and nephews.

A memorial services are set for Tuesday, June 11, at 10 a.m. at St. Agnes Episcopal Church with Father Norman Meserve officiating. Private interment will be at Swain Memorial Park in Bryson City.
