

## Death Takes Father Of Dr. Killian At Home In Hayesville

Dr. and Mrs. Frank M. Killian and four children were called to Hayesville last week by the illness and death of Dr. Killian's father, Dr. Paul B. Killian, 78, who died at his home in Hayesville Tuesday.

A physician, Dr. Killian was twice — 1915 and 1931 — Clay county representative in the general assembly, and had several times served as Clay county coroner.

A number of Franklin persons, in addition to the Killians, attended the funeral service, conducted Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Hayesville Methodist church.

Survivors, in addition to Dr. Frank M. Killian, include two other sons, Dr. Carl Killian of Western Carolina Teachers college, Cullowhee, and Ralph Killian, of Hayesville, and one daughter, Mrs. Ora McGlamery, of Hayesville.
