

# DON M. KIMSEY FUNERAL HELD

## Youth Who Drowned In Mississippi River Is Buried Here

Funeral services for Don M. Kimsey, who was drowned in the Mississippi river September 26, were held Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock at the Pleasant Hill Baptist church.

The 23-year-old Franklin maritime sailor was lost overboard from the U. S. Steamer Tuntis near Cairo, Ill. The body was recovered October 16, according to information received here from the U. S. Maritime commission.

Officiating at the services were the Rev. Claude Ledford and the Rev. James I. Vinson. Burial was in the church cemetery. Graveside rites were conducted by members of the local Veterans of Foreign Wars post.

Survivors include his mother, Mrs. Frank Carpenter and his step-father, Mr. Carpenter, of the Skeenah community; his widow, the former Miss Olga Nicholson, of the Cartoogechaye community; two sisters, Mrs. Sanford Dills, of Atlanta, Ga., and Mrs. Dillard Nicholson, of Cartoogechaye; and one half-sister, Delma Jean Carpenter, of the home.
