Cartoogechaye Merchant Succumbs to Stroke Of Paralysis

J. J. Kiser, 73, well known farmer and merchant of the Cartoogechaye section, died at his home Friday morning at 5 o'clock. He had been in declining health for four years. About ten days ago he suffered a stroke of paralysis, his fourth.

Funeral services were held at the Mt. Hope Baptist church Saturday morning at 11 o'clock with the Rev. A. S. Solesbee, pastor, in charge. Interment was in the Franklin cemetery.

The deceased is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Arthur Waldroop, Mrs. Oscar Lewis and Miss Amber Kiser, and three sons, Bunyan Kiser, Wood Kiser and Theo. W. Kiser, all of Macon county.

Mr. Kiser moved to Macon county from Rutherford county in 1911 and settled in the Cartoogechaye valley.
