Floyd Stephen Lamb, 34, of Lawrenceville, Ga., formerly of Macon County, died unexpectedly, Sunday, June 13, in Rabun County Memorial Hospital, of injuries received in a motorcycle accident. He was the son of the late Floyd Jackson Lamb and Anne Nichols Lamb, of Highlands, and married to Demetra Long Lamb.

He was a uniformed traffic officer in Gwinnett County, Ga., for the past 11 years. He was a member of the Highlands First Baptist Church.
