Mrs. Mary Ledbetter Dies On January 20

Mrs. Mary Crawford Ledbetter, of Franklin, Route 1, widow of Mark Ledbetter, died January 20 in a local hospital. Eighty-five, she had been in declining health. Funeral services for Mrs. Ledbetter, who was a native of Haywood County, were conducted the 22nd at the Carson Chapel Methodist Church by the Rev. Mark Rose and the Rev. Lee Crawford.
