

Mrs. A. J. Long Passed At Home In Ohio

News has been received here of the death of Mrs. Olivia D. Horn Long, 82, wife of Andrew Jack Long, formerly of Macon county, who died at their home in Peninsula, Ohio, on June 22. She was the daughter of William and Caroline Mashburn Long of Hiawassa, Ga., and was married to Mr. Long on November 29, 1882. For many years they made their home in Smithbridge township of Macon county, removing to Georgia about 30 years ago and to Ohio 10 years later.

To their union 10 children were born, six of whom are living. Burial was in Fairview cemetery, Boston Heights, Ohio.

Surviving are the husband, and the following children: Mrs. Arie Waldroop, Covington, Ga.; Mrs. Rosa Patrick, Ravenna, Ohio; Mrs. Zoah Lord, Winder, Ga.; Mrs. Beulah Rainey, Covington, Ga.; Lawrence N. Long, Peninsula, Ohio and Allen Long, Macedonia, Ohio. One brother, Jerome W. Horn of Young Cane, Ga., also survives and a half-sister, Mrs. M. M. Peppers of Hoschton, Ga.

Mr. Long has many friends and relatives in this county who will sympathize with him in the loss of his companion of over sixty years. While a resident here he was an active worker in the Hickory Knoll Methodist church, and most of their children were born here.
