Pauline Snyder Love, 98, of Franklin, died Tuesday, July 24, at her residence.

A native of Wardensville, W.Va., she was the daughter of the late Hayes and Mary Jane Phillips Snyder. She lived in Andrews and moved to Franklin in 1909. She taught in Nantahala Village, Spring Creek and Marion. She was a retired elementary school teacher where she taught in Macon, Cherokee, Madison and McDowell counties.
