

Mrs. Leila A. Lowery's Funeral In Waynesville

Mrs. Leila A. Lowery, 73, for 40 years a resident of this county, died in a Morganton hospital on Tuesday morning, November 18, after an illness of several years. Mrs. Lowery lived on her farm on the Georgia road a short distance from Franklin until her last illness.

The remains were taken to Waynesville, to the home of a sister, Mrs. I. G. Brown.

The funeral services were conducted in the Presbyterian church of that place and interment was in Green Hill cemetery on Wednesday afternoon. The Rev. Malcolm R. Williamson, pastor of the church, officiated.

Surviving besides her sister, Mrs. Brown, are four grandchildren, Walter Shierl Brown, Helen Allison Brown, Mildred Josephine Brown, and Clarence Brown, and a son-in-law, Walter Brown, of Wyoming. Mrs. Lowery's daughter, Mrs. Brown, mother of the grandchildren, died about 10 years ago. Mr. Brown was visiting in Macon county and attended the funeral.
