

Mrs. Margaret Mallonee Dies In Arlington, Wash.

Mrs. James L. Bryson, of West's Mill, received a message Tuesday telling of the death of her mother, Mrs. Margaret Mallonee, of Arlington, Wash. Mrs. Mallonee, 95, received a broken hip in a fall on February 23. She died on Monday, March 4.

Mrs. Mallonee was born in Macon county on August 23, 1844. She married Adam Mallonee, also of Macon county, and to this union was born eight children, seven of whom survive.

She resided in Macon and Jackson counties until 1923 when she left for Arlington, Wash.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. James L. Bryson, of West's Mill, and Mrs. Nannie Cowan, of Arlington, Wash., with whom the deceased resided; five sons, Joe Mallonee, of Addie, Jackson county; John Mallonee, of Almond, Swain county; Jess Mallonee, of Yakima, Wash., and David and Ben Mallonee, of Darrington, Wash.; 25 grandchildren; 28 great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandson.

Funeral services will be held in Arlington on Thursday. She was a member of the Methodist church.
