

**Mrs. Caroline Mann,
Macon Native, Dies
At Greensboro Home**

News was received here this week of the death in Greensboro January 14 of Mrs. Caroline Elizabeth Mann, 88, who was a native of Macon county.

Mrs. Mann, who was Miss Bradley before her marriage to the late Rev. George P. Mann, was reared near Otto. The family moved to Greensboro about 40 years ago, and have lived there ever since. Mr. Mann died soon after going to Greensboro.
