Dies Of Heart Attack At Newton

News was received here Monday of the death in Newton of George Weaver Mann, a native of Macon county, and a brother of J. J. Mann, principal of the Otto school.

Mr. Mann, who was editor and owner of the Catawba News-Enterprise at Newton, died of a heart attack, suffered at his office Monday morning. Funeral services here held in Newton Tuesday afternoon, and burial was there.

The son of the late Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Mann of Franklin, Mr. Mann was a graduate of the University of North Carolina, and held an M. A. degree from that institution. He was a member of the Catawba county board of education and was chairman of the county's draft board. During World War I, he served in the 30th division.

Survivors include his widow, Mrs. Ione Mebane Mann; one daughter, Mrs. David Corpening of Newton, and the following brothers and sisters: Frank Mann of Fairview, Mrs. B. H. Garland, Enka, Mrs. Mary Stamey, Greensboro, Mrs. Sara E. Nichols, Mt. Vernon, Wash., and James J. Mann of Franklin.
