## **Mr. Marett**

Norman, Charles Marett, of Otto, died Tuesday, July 10, at his residence.

A native of Manchester, N.H., he was the son of the late T. Charles and Ida Marett. He graduated high school in Dover, N.H. He attended Parks Air College of the University of St. Louis, where he received a B.S. in aeronautical engineering. He worked for Chance Vought Aircraft in Connecticut. During WWII he served as a Corsair aircraft technical representative for Vought.

He retired in 1977 as director of logistics and product support, and moved to Otto.
