

**MRS. MARTIN PASSES  
AT SON'S HOME IN FLORIDA**

Mrs. Margaret M. Martin, 83, a former Highlander, died at the home of her son, McCloy E. Martin, in Jacksonville, Fla., on July 1st, after a long illness. A native of Athens, Pa., Mrs. Martin first came to Highlands in 1942, and that summer operated a hotel then known as the Islington, where King's Inn now stands. In 1913, she took charge of the Daves House, (Tricemont Terrace), which was later given her name "The Martin". She continued to operate "The Martin" as a summer hotel until 1934.

Mrs. Martin was a member of the Episcopal church and active in church work. She was an accomplished musician, serving as organist for the Church of the Incarnation here many summers.
