

West's Mill Resident Passes Wednesday

Levi Elijah (Dude) Mathis, 55, died at his home in the West's Mill section of Macon county on Wednesday morning at 5 o'clock following a lingering illness of several months caused by three strokes of apoplexy.

Mr. Mathis, a life-long resident of Macon county, was born on October 8, 1889, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. W. W. Mathis. He was a farmer and had made his home in the West's Mill community for a number of years. He was married to Miss Sara Prince on August 16, 1914.
