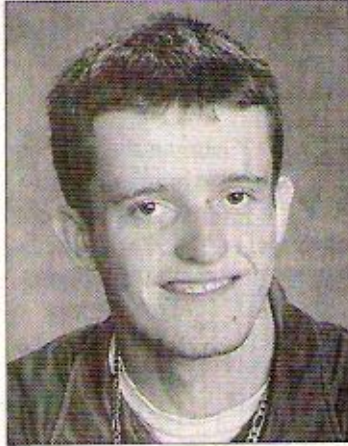


Joseph Cody Mayberry
