

Mack M'Call, Maconian, Dies At 85

Farmer Succumbs
In Hospital;
Rites Sunday

Mack McCall, 85, farmer and Macon County native, died Saturday at 8:20 a.m. at Angel Hospital. He had been ill a week.

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at the Sugarfork Baptist Church by the Rev. George Cloey and the Rev. William Shields. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Born May 20, 1873, Mr. McCall was the son of George and Mrs. Peggy Barnes Teague McCall. He was a member of the Pine Grove Baptist Church and was married in 1894 to Miss Frances Wood, of this county, who died in January, 1953.
