

Emory McDonald, Former Resident, Dies

Funeral services for Emory McDonald, will be held on Sunday at 2 p. m. at the Louisa Methodist church on Cartoogechaye. The Rev. Philip L. Green, pastor, will be in charge of the services. Interment will be in the church cemetery.
