

## McDonald Dies Monday At 70 In Salisbury

William N. McDonald, a Macon County native and farmer of Franklin, Route 5 (Bethel section), died Monday, March 8, at 1:25 a.m. in a Salisbury hospital at the age of 70. He had been in declining health for some time.

Funeral services for Mr. McDonald, a veteran of World War I, were conducted the 10th at 2:30 p.m. at the Bethel Methodist Church by the Rev. Mark Rose, Jr., pastor, and the Rev. D. P. Grant. Burial was in the church cemetery. Members of V.F.W. Post 7339 served as pallbearers and conducted graveside rites.

Born Jan. 30, 1895, Mr. McDonald was the son of the late Thomas and Mrs. Rosetta Dills McDonald. He was married Sept. 10, 1933 to Miss Charlotte Johnson, of this county, who survives.
