

## J. L. Moore Dies In Fla.

The Rev. James L. Moore, 83, a native of Macon County, died Thursday, May 31, at his home in Lake Helen, Fla.

A graduate of Western Carolina Teachers College and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Mr. Moore was pastor of a number of churches in Florida from 1912 until his retirement in 1955.

Funeral services were conducted Monday in Deland.
