

MRS. MATTIE S. MOORE, 91, DIES AT HOME HERE

Funeral services were held for Mrs. Mattie Sherrill Moore, 91, who died Saturday night in her home here after a long illness, at 3 p. m. Sunday in the Franklin Methodist church.

The Rev. C. E. Murray and the Rev. Hoyt Evans conducted the service and burial followed in the Franklin cemetery.
