

Mrs. Lou Ellen Morgan Succumbs To Illness

Mrs. Lou Ellen Morgan, lifelong resident of Macon County, died at Kyle after a short illness Friday, October 6. She was seventy-four years old.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at the Iotia Baptist church and burial was in the church cemetery. Rev. R. F. Mayberry and Rev. William Sorrels officiated.

Mrs. Morgan was born on March 5, 1870, the daughter of Ephriam and Sally Tallent. Her husband, W. R. Morgan, died in November, 1932. She was a member of the Iotia Baptist church.
