

Mrs. Pierce Moses, Passes In California

A message has been received by Lewis Moses, of the Ellijay section of Macon county, stating that his mother, Mrs. Harriett Charlotte Moses, 79, had died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Julia Peterson in El Centro, Calif., on Sunday, March 11, following a lingering illness of several months.

Mrs. Moses, a native of Transylvania county, was married to the late T. Pierce Moses, of the Ellijay community and moved to Macon county a number of years ago. She lived here until about 1940 when she went to California to make her home with her daughters.
