

R. H. Munger Dies Thursday In Highlands

Robert Henry Munger, Highlands carpenter, died Thursday, May 16, at 5:55 p. m. at Highlands Community Hospital. He was 87 and had been ill for several weeks.

Funeral services for Mr. Munger, a native of Attica, N.Y., were conducted the 17th at 4 p.m. at the Highlands Methodist Church by the Rev. James Thurman, pastor. Burial was in the Highlands Cemetery with

members of the Masonic Lodge serving as pallbearers.

Born July 9, 1875, he was the son of the late William and Mrs. Emma Louise Ship-

man Munger. He was a Methodist and was married to Miss Nancy Ann Barnes, of Jackson County, who died in 1925.

Surviving are two sons, William R. Munger, of Atlanta, Ga., and Samuel R. Munger, of Alexandria, Va.; a daughter, Mrs. Marvin L.
