Daniel Patrick Murray, 91, of Franklin, died Saturday, May 10, 2003, in a local hospital.

A native of New York, N.Y., he was the son of the late John and Delia Martin Murray. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Margaret Murray, who died in 1996. He was a retired detective for the New York City Police Department and was a member of the Broward County 1013 retired N.Y. City Police Officers Club. He was of the Catholic faith.
