Jack "Ted" Neiman Jr., 82, formerly of Gatlinburg, Tenn., died Sunday, Aug. 29, 2004, in Siguatepeque, Honduras.



A native of Denver, Colo., he was the son of the late Nathan Neiman and Amy Brown Neiman. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a daughter, Meda Neiman and a grandson. He was a Navy pilot serving in World War II and Korea, flying Air America in Vietnam.
