Marshall G. Nichols, 47, of Route 1, Franklin, died Wednesday, March 27, in the V.A. Hospital at Oteen after a brief illness. He was a native of Macon County, the son of Beulah Dills Nichols and the late William Floyd Nichols, and was married to the late Eva Ischner, of Berlin, Germany, who died in 1963.
