

## Pfc. Manuel L. Norton Killed In Action

Mr. and Mrs. Mann B. Norton, of Franklin route 2, have received a message from the War Department stating that their son, Pfc. Manuel L. Norton, who was seriously wounded in action in Germany on February 19, died from the wounds on February 27.

Pfc. Norton entered the services on May 16, 1944, at Fort Bragg and took his basic training at Fort McClellan, Ala. Following 17 weeks of training he was given a 12 day furlough which he spent with his wife, two children and parents. Following his furlough he reported back to Fort George Meade, Md. He was in action in England, Scotland, France and Germany.

Surviving are the widow and two small children, the parents, and a number of brothers and sisters.
