

Aged Resident Passes At Daughter's Home

Mrs. Ruhamah Pannell, 89, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Will Mason on Bonny Crest, on Thursday morning at 8 o'clock, following a critical illness of one week, although she had been a semi-invalid for a number of years.

Born in 1855, the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. W. F. Angel, she was a life-long resident of Macon county. She was a member of the Bethel Methodist church, and was twice married. The first marriage was to Albert Calloway, and following his death she was married to Ellsha Pannell, who also preceded her in death a few years ago.
