

Sam Passmore

Sam Passmore, a Macon County native who had in recent years resided in the Cartoogechaye Community, died Monday in the C. J. Harris Community Hospital in Sylva.

The son of the late Thomas and Lydia Bingham Passmore, he had married the late Dorothy Heath Passmore.

He spent most of his life in Western North Carolina working for the Ecusta Plant at Brevard for 13 years and operating Sam's Boats and Cabins in the Nantahala section for 17 years.
