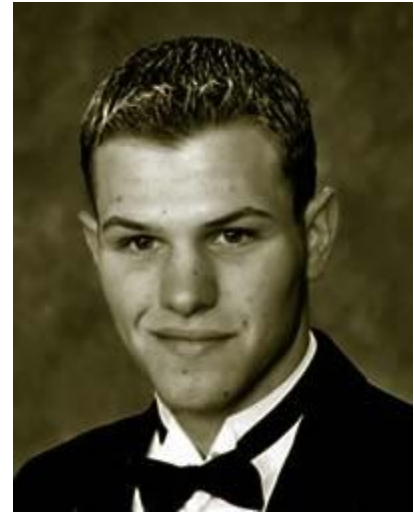
A memorial service was held at 7 p.m., Tuesday, March 4, at Prentiss Church of God, with Revs. Don Moffitt and Radford Penland officiating.
