

W. PENLAND, 55, DIES IN OREGON

Native Of This County
Succumb To Heart
Attack

Word has been received here of the death of Witham Penland, a native of Franklin, at Nehalem, Oregon, where he had made his home for the past 11 years.

Mr. Penland, aged 55, died September 11, following a heart attack.

Born here April 11, 1896, he married Miss Sadie Stiles November 25, 1917. In 1923 he moved his family to Arlington, Wash., and in 1940 moved from Arlington to Nehalem, where he was a logger, and later engaged in the restaurant business.

He was a veteran of World War 1.

Survivors include his widow; four daughters, Mrs. Charles Downie, Mrs. Merle Hester, Mrs. Joseph Zagata, and Miss Sharon Penland, all of Nehalem; a brother, Lawrence Penland, of Franklin; two sisters, Mrs. George Rush and Mrs. Bart Fulcher, both of Franklin; and five grandsons.

Funeral services and burial were at Nehalem.
