

## Services For Mrs. Phillips Held Friday

Mrs. Ethel Gribble Phillips, formerly of Clay County, was found dead about noon March 4 on the back porch of her home in the Cartoogechaye section by her husband, Frank Phillips, and her brother, Fred Gribble, of Hayesville.

A coroner's jury ruled she had hanged herself. Mrs. Phillips had been in poor health for some time.
