

# MACK PIERSON FUNERAL HELD

## Highlands Man Dies In Winston-Salem Hospital

Funeral services for Mack A. Pierson, 63, were held Saturday afternoon at 3 o'clock in the Highlands Baptist church, with the Rev. Paul C. Nix, pastor, officiating. Burial was in Highlands cemetery.
