

Florence Porterfield

Mrs. Florence Volk Porterfield, 82, a native of Iowa who had resided in Highlands for the past 20 years, died Friday in the Highlands-Cashiers Hospital.

She was the widow of the late Col. Herbert D. Porterfield, who died June 3, 1969.

Col. and Mrs. Porterfield were married in Iowa June 27, 1916.
