

Rev. J. C. Postelle Dies At His Home In Lenoir

Rev. J. C. Postelle, for 45 years a Methodist preacher and well known throughout North Carolina, died at his home at Lenoir, N. C., last Monday afternoon. He was pastor of the Burnsville Methodist church eight years ago. He retired at the Gastonia conference four years ago and since has lived quietly at Lenoir. He was buried in that city last Tuesday. Many years ago Rev. Postelle was pastor of the Franklin Methodist church. He will be remembered by the older members of the Methodist congregation.
