

Neville L. Ramey

Neville L. Ramey, 78 year old native of Swain County died Sunday in a local hospital following an illness of eleven months. He was a resident of Route 1, Franklin.

He was the son of the late James and Margaret Moffitt Ramey, and in 1931 had married Miss Bessie Watts. He was a veteran of World War I and a member of American Legion Post 108.
