

E. Wolfard Renshaw

Word has been received here of the death of E. Wolfard Renshaw, 78, of Moscow, Idaho. Mr. Renshaw died Monday, September 11, after a long illness. Funeral services and burial were in Kamlah, Idaho.

Prior to his retirement from the U.S. Forest Service in 1955 Mr. Renshaw was Supervisor of the Nantahala National Forest and he and his family made their home in Franklin.

He is survived by his wife; two daughters, Mrs. Maxine R. Cochran, of Clawson, Mich.; and Mrs. Wilma Corbin, of Franklin; one son, Richard Renshaw, of San Francisco, Calif.; and six grandchildren.
