

Funeral For Mrs. Mae Richardson Held Saturday

Final rites for Mrs. Mae Cochran Richardson, of Gastonia, formerly of the Burningtown section of Macon county, were held on Saturday morning, November 17, at 11 o'clock, at the Burningtown Baptist church. The Rev. Norman E. Holden, officiated, assisted by the Rev. John Brendle. Interment followed in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Richardson died in the Baptist hospital in Winston-Salem on Thursday very unexpectedly, although she had been in ill health for more than a year.
