

J. A. (Al) Riddle, 78, of 236 Porter Street, Franklin, died Friday, June 28, in the V.A. Hospital at Oteen after a long illness. He was a native of South Carolina and was married to Mrs. Margaret Flanagan Riddle, who survives. He was a veteran of the U. S. Army, World War I.
